Unfortunately, the parent survey showed that an after-school club would not be a viable proposition: out of 71 families, only 19 responded and out of those, only 68% said that they might use the service. We will continue to monitor the situation, but in the meantime our lovely staff will continue to give up their time to provide extra-curricular activities on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays. We are hopeful that from January we will be able to offer a Musical Theatre Club on Thursdays and Football on Fridays; these will be fee paying, through the use of outside companies.
